Day 1: Friday, June 21, 2024 Washington, D.C. - Tour

Begins Set forth on a grand historical tour featuring the timeless elegance and heritage of The Greenbrier. Experience this jewel of classic American resorts and come to understand its draw of over 200 years. A journey brimming with the history of America begins in Washington, D.C.

Day 2: Saturday, June 22, 2024 Washington, D.C. A picture-perfect day in DC starts at the White House Visitor Center, seeing artifacts from the White House collection. Take a tour of DC's world-famous memorials and monuments, including the National World War II Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial, and Vietnam Veterans Memorial. Uncover treasures of the Smithsonian Institution with free time to visit any of the museums surrounding the National Mall – perhaps you'll take one small step into space exploration at the National Air and Space Museum, or explore facets of the nation's story at the National Museum of American History. Arlington, VA - White Sulphur Springs, WV This morning, visit Arlington National Cemetery. A narrated tour takes you to the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Kennedy gravesites. This afternoon, make a stop at historical Front Royal for some free time before traveling through the beautiful mountains of West Virginia to White Sulphur Springs, arriving at The Greenbrier, the world-class resort that's been welcoming guests since 1778. This evening, dine amid the grandeur of this historic resort. (B, D)

Day 4: Monday, June 24, 2024 The Greenbrier Resort

With a storied past to explore and every resort luxury available to you, it's time to enjoy all The Greenbrier has to offer. This is a place steeped in history, from its earliest days when its natural mineral springs drew guests to "take the waters," to its long-established status as an elite retreat, where five sitting presidents had already stayed before the Civil War. Imagine these same grounds, repurposed by the U.S. government as well as the army during periods of war over the centuries. Take an introductory tour of the vast property before continuing on a guided tour of the formerly classified government bunker built under the West Virginia Wing in the 1950s. The rest of the day is yours to spend as you please throughout the resort. Fill it with relaxing pastimes* such as croquet, horseback riding, swimming, or shopping, enjoy a traditional afternoon tea, or try your luck at the Greenbrier Casino Club. Enjoy dining at the resort once again this evening. (B, D)

Day 5: Tuesday, June 25, 2024 White Sulphur Springs -

Charlottesville - Richmond, VA Feeling restored, bid farewell to The Greenbrier. Today, visit Monticello, the beautiful home and gardens of Thomas Jefferson, the third president of the United States and author of the Declaration of Independence. Tour the main house and take time to explore the area. After departing, an 18th-century tavern beckons a stop to experience age-old hospitality with a hearty meal. Then in Richmond, **it's your choice!** Join a local guide for a walking history tour of Richmond's Jackson Ward neighborhood, a center of African

Day 6: Wednesday, June 26, 2024 Richmond - Williamsburg - Richmond Today, step back in time and explore Colonial Williamsburg, where historical reenactors and artisans populate the streets and buildings, bringing 1770 to life. Enjoy time to tour this iconic site independently: Wander the cobblestone streets, explore the historic buildings, and enjoy lunch on your own with your pick of colonial or modern-style eateries on the grounds. Back in Richmond tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner with your fellow travelers at a local restaurant, just steps from the hotel. (B, D)

Day 7: Thursday, June 27, 2024 Richmond - Washington D.C. Depart Richmond today heading toward Washington, D.C. Make a stop in Old Town Alexandria with some free time to explore and enjoy lunch on your own. Then, visit Mount Vernon, the beloved home of George Washington. After a tour

of the home, spend time wandering through the gardens and grounds before visiting the tomb of General Washington and his wife, Martha. Continue to your hotel for the evening and join a final toast to this historic journey. (B)

Day 8: Friday, June 28, 2024 Washington, D.C. - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close this morning. (B)

Experience It! Colonial Williamsburg

Williamsburg (originally Middle Plantation) was established to be the capital of the Colony of Virginia in 1699. As threats of enemy attack closed in during the Revolutionary War, the capital was moved inland to Richmond, where it would remain. After the Revolution, no longer the seat of the government, Williamsburg fell into decline through the years. It wasn't until the 1900s that efforts began to restore the 18th century town and preserve its history. In 1932, the Raleigh Tavern first opened as a public exhibition building. Today, Colonial Williamsburg is the world's largest living history museum with its 301 acres featuring restored and recreated historic buildings and taverns, and two world-class art museums.

IDENTIFICATION

Travel within USA

For travel completed by May 6, 2025, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo I.D.) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

Effective for travel May 7, 2025 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. To complete your tour, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

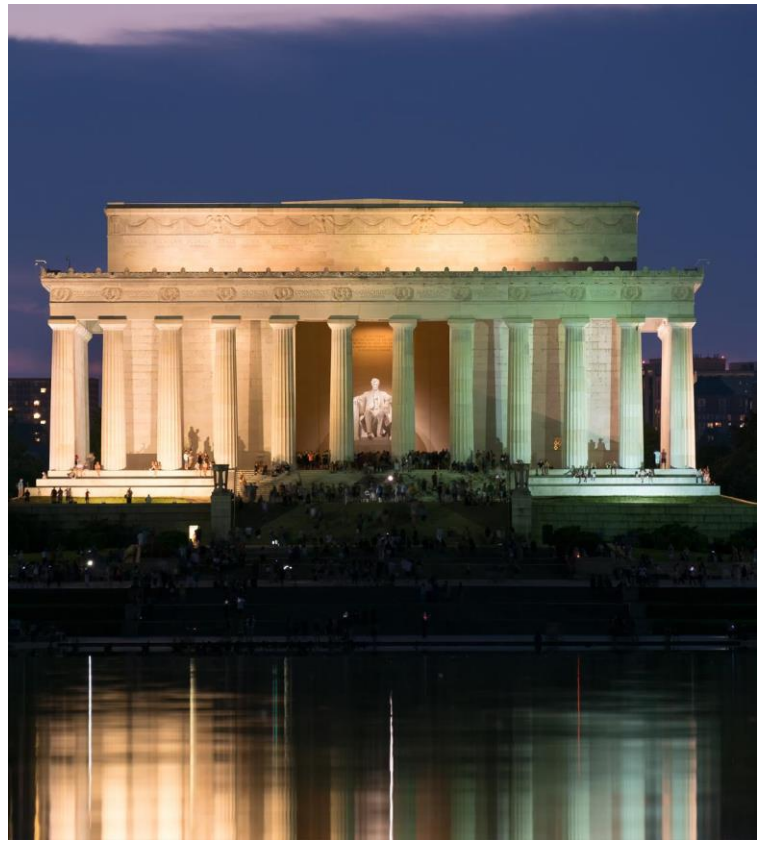
*While there are a number of included activities you can partake in at The Greenbrier Resort, others are paid and may require advanced reservations. To reserve a paid activity ahead of your trip, you can book directly with the resort.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 1. This means you're a leisurely traveler. You typically take it easy and discover the energy of a new place by people-watching or soaking in the atmosphere at a local café. You can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a coach, and walk unassisted at a relaxed pace for up to 60 minutes without difficulty. If choosing the walking tour in Richmond, you will need to be able to walk for up to 2 hours with some breaks along the way. You can easily handle altitudes up to 5,000 feet.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.
